Excursions

Visitors who should be in isolation OR with any of the following symptoms should not enter TwistED Science premises:

Fever
Chills
Cough
Sore Throat
Shortness of breath
Runny Nose
Loss of Sense of Smell

At entry all visitors should

- 1. Sanitise their hands before entry.
- 2. Maintain safe social distancing procedures.

TwistED Science staff will bring one group into the premises at a time. Other groups, if present, must wait outside until the entering group is past the reception desk.

TwistED Science staff are trained to keep everything as clean as possible. We will clean and sanitise high touch items between sessions, and replace equipment that cannot be cleaned between sessions.

Density quotients for our premises will be adhered to by limiting patrons as appropriate.

Schools

- School will be notified of our requirements prior to our visit.
- On entry and before entering a workshop, all teachers and students must sanitise as per standard procedure.
- Students may not be required to social distance, unless the school procedure requires otherwise.
- All adults and staff members must socially distance.
- Staff and students must not attend if unwell. Staff or students who develop symptoms during the visit must be isolated and sent home for testing as soon as possible.

The organiser will be asked to ensure that all guests who should be isolating are not present at the event. The organiser will be asked to make sure that density limits and visitor caps are maintained according to current government mandates.

Each guest will be required to

- 1. Sanitise their hands before participating.
- 2. Maintain safe social distancing procedures.

During session:

- All staff members will sanitise their hands if touching a surface touched by a guest, or after touching their face, drinking water, blowing their nose etc.
- Encourage guests to maintain safe COVID practices including social distancing and hand sanitising.

Cleaning between sessions:

All shared equipment will be either put away for cleaning later and replaced, or sanitised between sessions.

End of session:

All equipment that has been used must be cleaned with hot soapy water and sanitised, or thrown out, depending on the item.
